API Events' public relations strategy was extensive and multilayered, with the use of local, regional, and global PR agencies and content specialists, and influencers such as Ask Ash. Our Primary agencies were DMIX and APO, along with paid industry media partners such as Asset Magazine, Property Flash, Property Wheel, African Decisions, and AH Reports.

The total PR spend amounted to USD 30,269,100, covering campaigns for the awards, the summit, hospitality sessions, and the Proptech forum. Between June 21 and September 20, these efforts generated over 313 947 impressions across various websites and social media platforms. Key media outlets, including CNBC Africa, Zawya.com, Socialnews.xyz, Vox Africa, and African Business were among the most influential channels to feature the release.
